- Inform and educate farmworkers about their rights and responsibilities as members of the community.
- Advocate for the hiring of bilingual personnel in agencies and service organizations in Western NY.
- Gather and coordinate valuable resources for farmworkers.

Outreach & Advocacy:

Experienced Outreach Advocates assist farmworkers and migrant families by:

- Advocating for Farmworkers and migrants
- Providing Know Your Rights Education in Immigration & Employment Rights and Pesticide Safety to ensure workers can exercise their rights.
- Organize community events such as Health Fairs and a Christmas Fiesta for parents and children throughout the year.
- Assisting individuals experiencing emergencies with shelter, food, other basic needs.

Legal Services:

- Represent survivors of labor trafficking in their immigration matters.
- Educate workers about labor trafficking, their rights, and the legal process.
- Support clients in reporting to authorities & ensure respect for their rights
- Provide training to partner organizations & government agencies about labor trafficking, services available, and referral process.
- Provide comprehensive Case Management services for survivors.
